Breaking Ground

Work is due to begin in early May 2018 and will take around 6 months to complete. It will start with the removal of the current storage block behind the existing building, and the laying of foundations for the new changing rooms, showers and toilets (including disabled facilities).

The second phase will see the complete restructuring of the existing building, with a new roof, doors and windows, an expanded and refitted kitchen and a main hall twice the size of the current function room. This new room will have wooden floors, roof lights and modern lighting to make it light, airy and welcoming.
