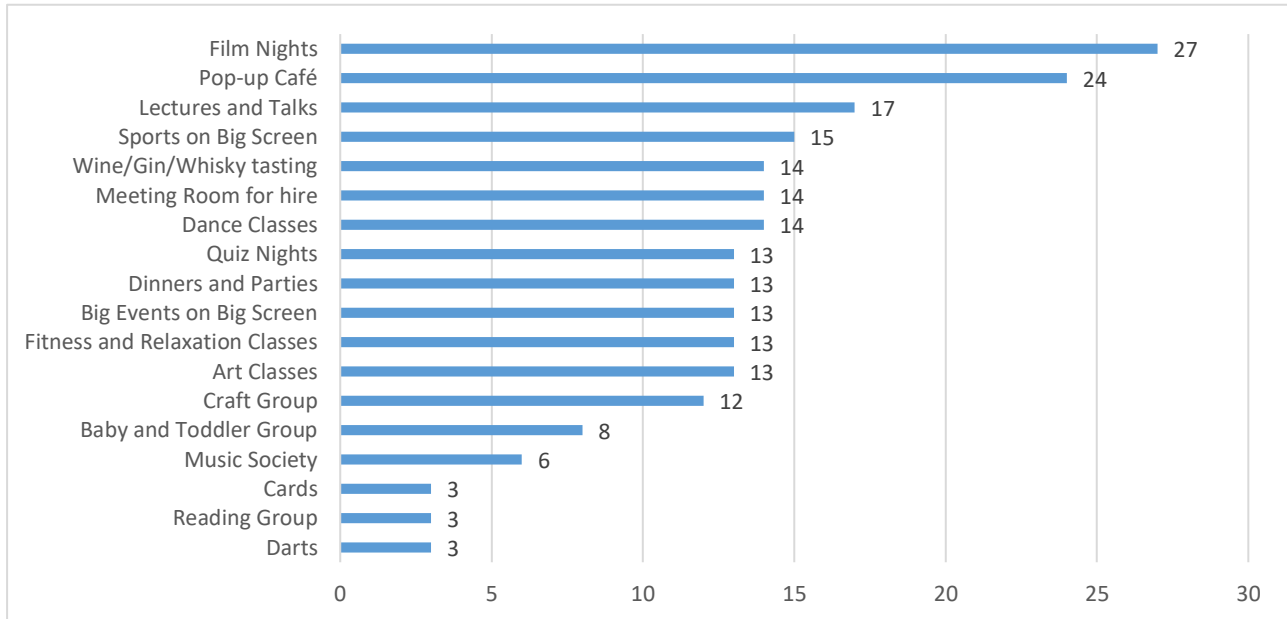


# King George's Field Plans
